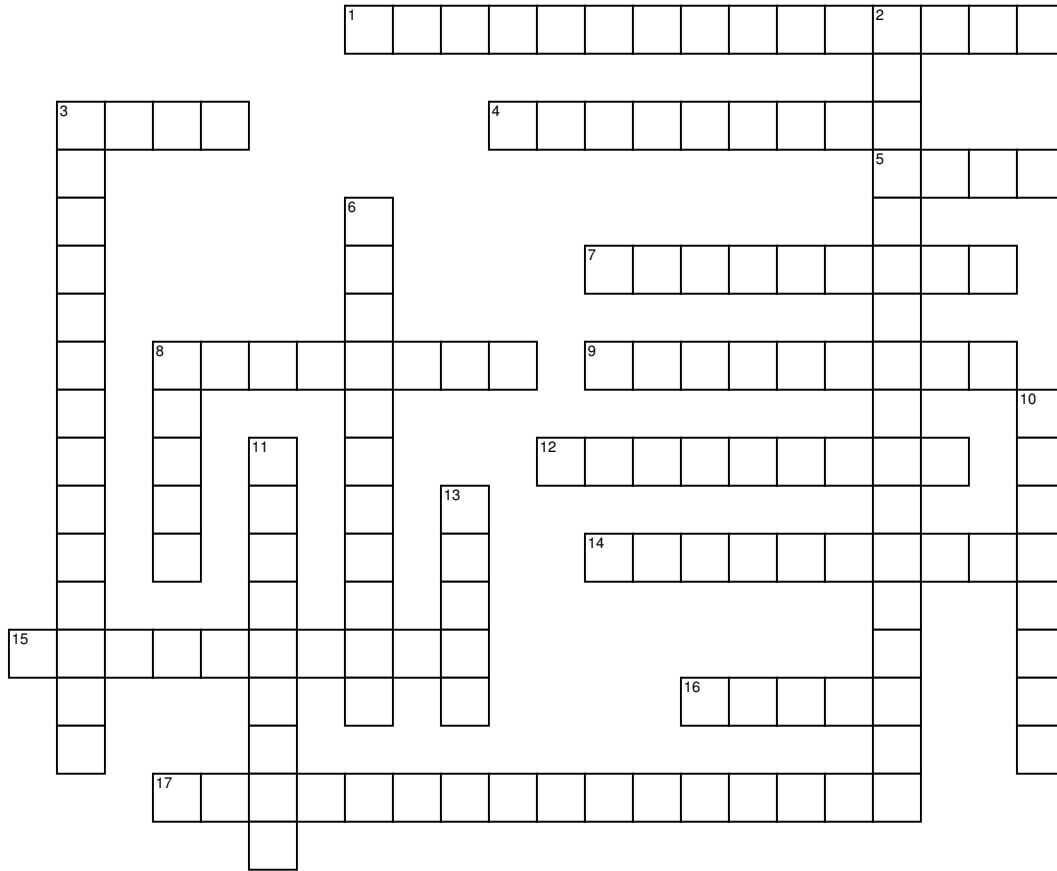

ACROSS

- 1 This statement reverses the polarity of the specified motor.
- 3 The text part of the written program is called this.
- 4 All statements in RobotC end with this.
- 5 When using robotC you are basically writing the code in this first, then the program is compiled into a form understood by the robot.
- 7 This type of control structure causes the code to be repeated over and over.
- 8 Text within a program that the code ignores.
- 9 This code command forces the robot to sit for a specified amount of milliseconds
- 12 When programming you must and talk about these as a way of predicting what the robot must do.
- 14 A hybrid language halfway between English and programming language.
- 15 A double forward slash can be used to leave this type of comment.
- 16 When organizing your code it is important that your statements are in this so that the program runs smoothly.
- 17 These must be used to designate special areas in the code or within a command that have special meaning.
